Attendance Criteria for Non-Community Members

Student Name _____

For student(s) of Native American descent not currently residing on the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community.

1. Student(s) must attend school regularly and in accordance with SRPMIC Tribal Ordinance SRO-459-2015.
2. Notify the school on the same day if student(s) will be absent.
3. Student(s) must be in school by 8:15 AM every day. Excessive tardies will contribute to having your student(s) dropped.
4. If student(s) is dropped for attendance and/or tardy problems, the student(s) will have to return to their original school or another school district to complete the current school year.
5. Student(s) who are dropped from Salt River Elementary School enrollment **will not be allowed to re-enroll for the remaining current school year.**
6. Because student(s) live outside of the Community, transportation will not be provided by the school. Parents are responsible for transporting the student(s) to and from school on time every day school is in session.
7. Parents are responsible for reading the Student Handbook, signing the Parent/Student Acknowledgement form, and familiarizing themselves with SRES policies and expectations.
