Child Find Program: Measuring Milestones

As children grow, they are constantly learning and reaching new milestones every day through play, watching other children and engaging with their family.

At the screening we:

- Conduct a developmental, hearing and vision screening in a play like format
- Provide suggestions that promote learning through play
- Support families with any recommended referrals or evaluations

The screening can be conducted at the clinic during your child's well-child check-up, in your home or in the Child Find office. Several times during the year we also offer large

Our staff believes that parents are their child's first teachers, and we can help provide learning activities that families can easily do at home, to assist children in their development.



It is recommended by the American Academy of Pediatrics to have children screened at regular intervals. Child Find does developmental screenings at 1, 2, 4, 6, 8, 9, 10, 12, 14, 16, 18, 20, 22, 24, 27, 30, 33, 36, 42, 48, 54, and 60 months of age.
