Dear Parents & Guardians,

Salt River Elementary School is offering a free, four-week pre-Kindergarten summer school program for students entering kindergarten this fall (2021-2022 school year). The goal of this program is to introduce students and families to the new school environment. Students will participate in reading, writing, math, fine and gross motor skills, and art activities. They will also learn about school routines and participate in group activities that promote social interactions and introduce them to school readiness skills for kindergarten success. Students will be served breakfast and lunch at school. Students may also enjoy guest speaker presentations and/or possible field trips. Parent participation is encouraged through parent meetings and weekly make and take activities.

The program will take place in person at SRES Monday-Thursday, June 21-July 15, from 8 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. with the exception of the week of July 5 the program would be Tuesday through Friday. Bus transportation is provided to students residing within SRPMIC boundaries. All health and safety precautions will be taken to prevent the spread of illness, but we also ask families to self-monitor and keep their children home if their child has a fever. The number of students accepted will be limited to ten students per classroom to adhere to appropriate social distancing guidelines.

PLEASE NOTE: The program is contingent upon the SRPMIC reopening plan. You will be notified of any changes.

Completion of the SRES enrollment packet (<u>sres.saltriverschools.org/parent\_info/forms</u>) is required for application consideration. Students will be expected to follow all SRES rules and expectations, including **attending school and arriving on time every day**. Students may be dropped from the program after two absences (excused/unexcused) or after three behavioral incidents.

First priority will be given to students who have **not** received any early childhood services (preschool, child care, etc.). Second priority will be given to students who have received some early childhood services, but who have special needs that make transition services beneficial.

Participation in the program does **not** take the place of 180 days in kindergarten, it is a program to support transition to Kindergarten later in summer. This program is funded by SRPMIC First Things First. If you have any questions, please contact us at 480-362-2400.
