

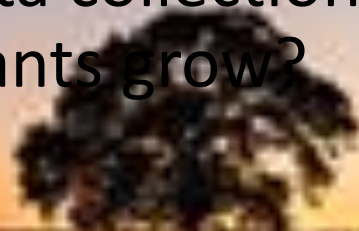
Moon Planting- Myth or Fact?

Hypothesis

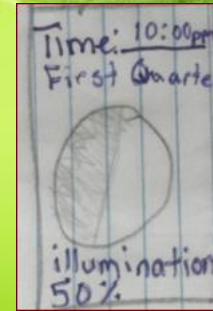

Seeds planted = Zucchini and Cantaloupe

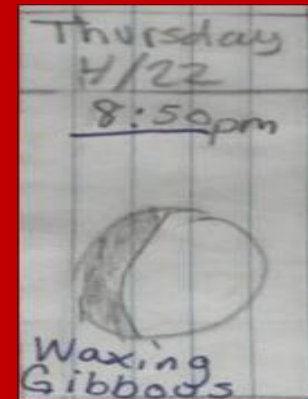
