Dear Parents & Guardians,

Salt River Elementary School, with funding from First Things First, is offering a free, four-week pre-Kindergarten summer school program for students entering kindergarten this fall (2023-2024 school year). The goal of this program is to introduce students and families to the new school environment. Students will participate in reading, writing, math, fine and gross motor skills, and art activities. They will also learn about school routines and participate in group activities that promote social interactions and introduce them to school readiness skills for kindergarten success. Students will be served breakfast and lunch at school. Students may also enjoy guest speaker presentations and/or possible field trips. Parent participation is encouraged through parent meetings and weekly make and take activities.

The program will take place in person at SRES from May 30 to June 23rd, from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Bus transportation is provided to students residing within SRPMIC boundaries. *All health and safety precautions will be taken to prevent the spread of illness, but we also ask families to self-monitor and keep their children home if their child has a fever.*

Completion of the SRES enrollment packet (<u>sres.saltriverschools.org/parent_info/forms</u>) is required for application consideration. Students will be expected to follow all SRES rules and expectations, including **attending school and arriving on time every day**. Students may be dropped from the program after <u>two absences (unexcused)</u> or after <u>three behavior incidents</u>.

First priority will be given to students who have <u>not</u> received any early childhood services (preschool, child care, etc.). Second priority will be given to students who have received some early childhood services, but who have special needs that make transition services beneficial.

Participation in the program does <u>not</u> take the place of 180 days in kindergarten, it is a program to support transition to Kindergarten. This program is funded by SRPMIC First Things First. If you have any questions, please contact us at (480)362-2400.
